NATIVITY & CAROL SERVICE

- The Christmas Nativity & Carol Service will take place on Monday, 21st December 2015 at 7.30pm in St. Mary's Church, Drom.
- Children should arrive in the church no later than 7.15pm wearing their costumes / uniforms.
- PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD BRINGS THEIR COSTUME TO SCHOOL IN A BAG ON THURSDAY, 19TH DECEMBER FOR A DRESS REHEARSAL. PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEM CLEARLY.**
- Children are reminded to bring all their props / instruments on the night.
- The service will be in two parts – The nativity followed by a carol service. Infants – First Class children will return to their parents after the nativity.

IRISH DANCING LESSONS

Irish Dancing with Sinéad Cahill will take place in Term 2 from Wednesday, 13th January 2016 to Wednesday, 16th March 2016. The programme is 10 weeks in duration. We would ask for a contribution of €1.50 per student per week to cover the cost of this programme. Children should wear their tracksuit and runners for Irish dancing.

TRACKSUIT: TERM 2

In Term 2, children will be required to wear their tracksuit on Wednesday for Irish Dancing classes and Friday for Hurling Training. The students should wear their school uniform on all other school days.
