#### **IRISH DANCING LESSONS**

Irish Dancing with Sinéad Cahill will take place in Term 2 from Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> January 2017 to Thursday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017. The programme is 10 weeks in duration. We would ask for a contribution of €1.50 per student per week to cover the cost of this programme. Students should wear their runners and tracksuits for Irish dancing classes.

#### TRACKSUIT: TERM 2
