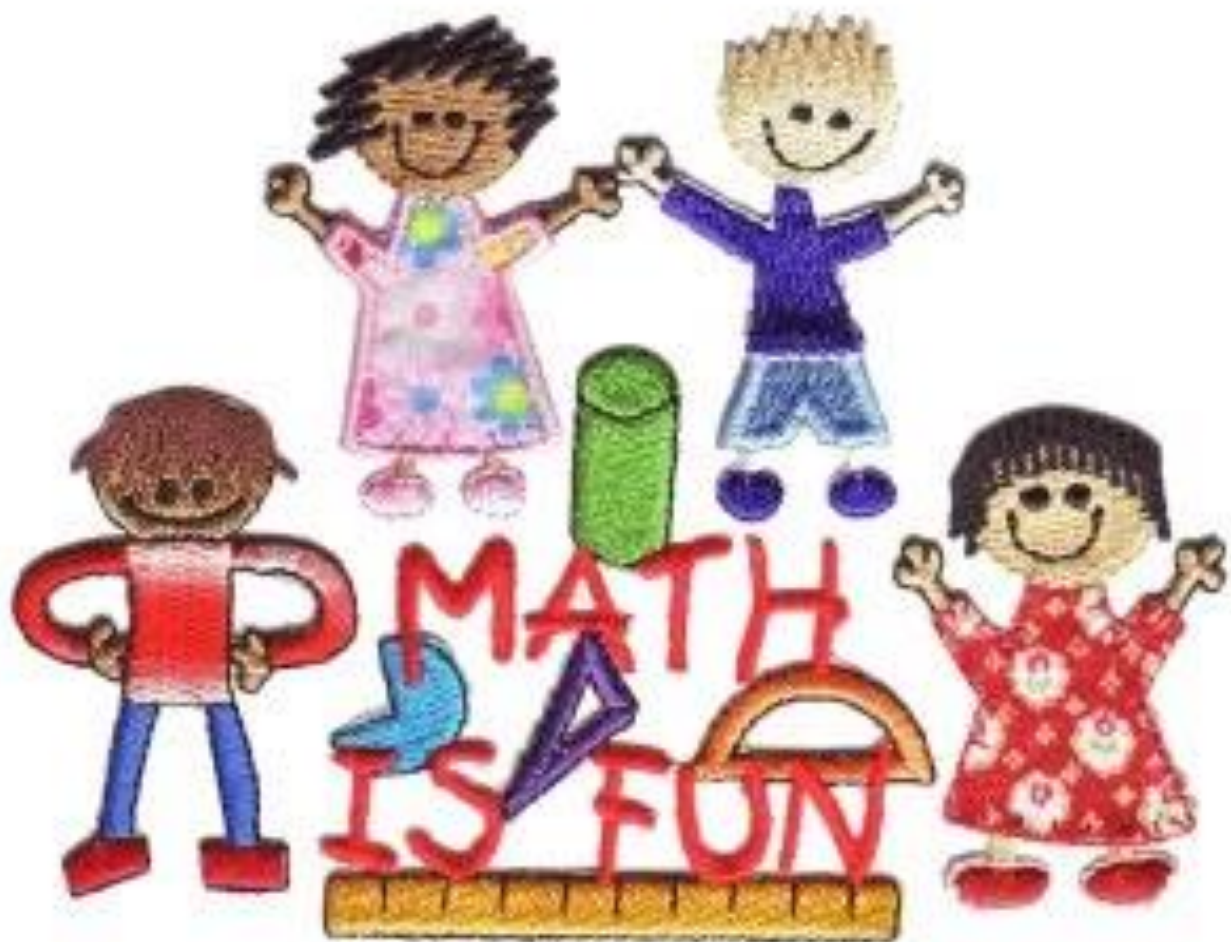

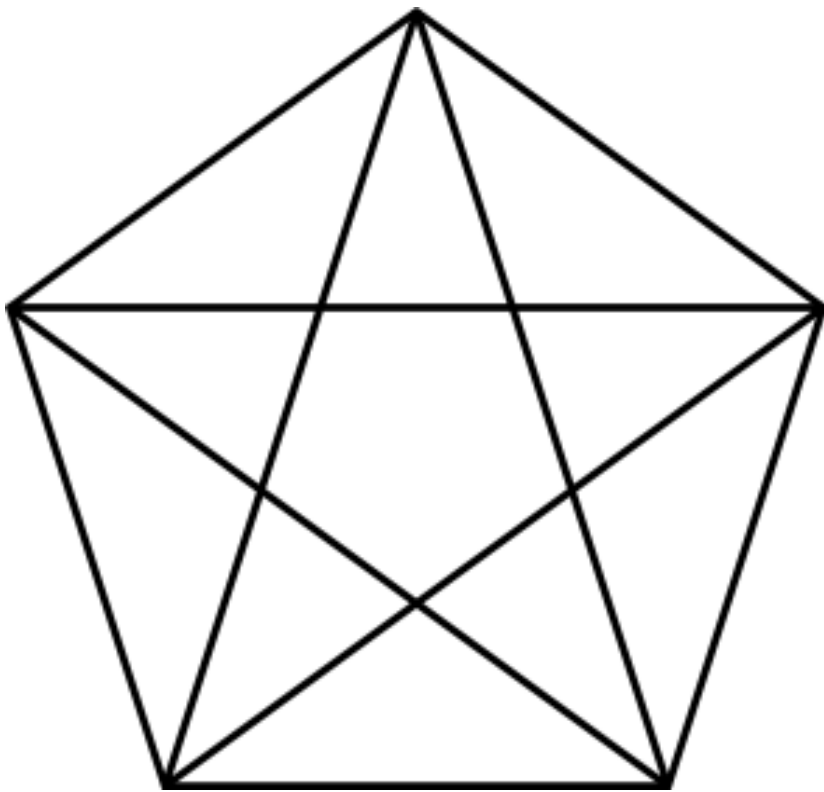
A milkman has an 8-litre container full of milk, and also two empty containers that measure 5 litres and 3 litres. He needs to deliver 4 litres of milk to a customer.

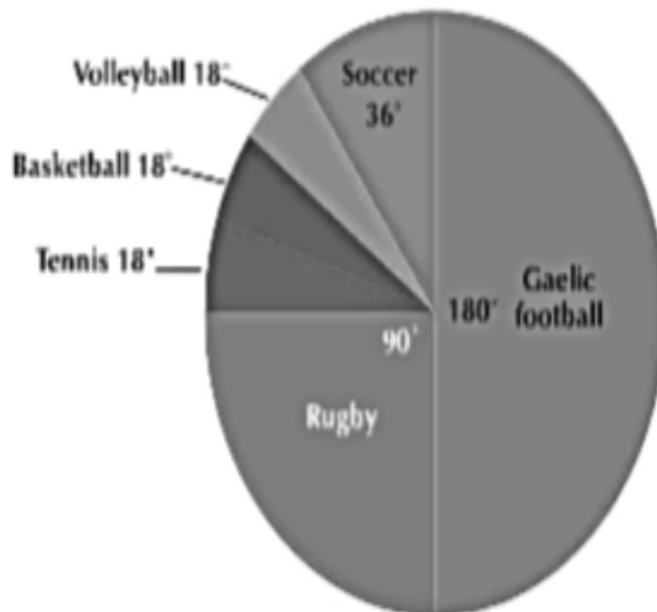


How many triangles?

4. 4 people prefer either basketball or tennis.

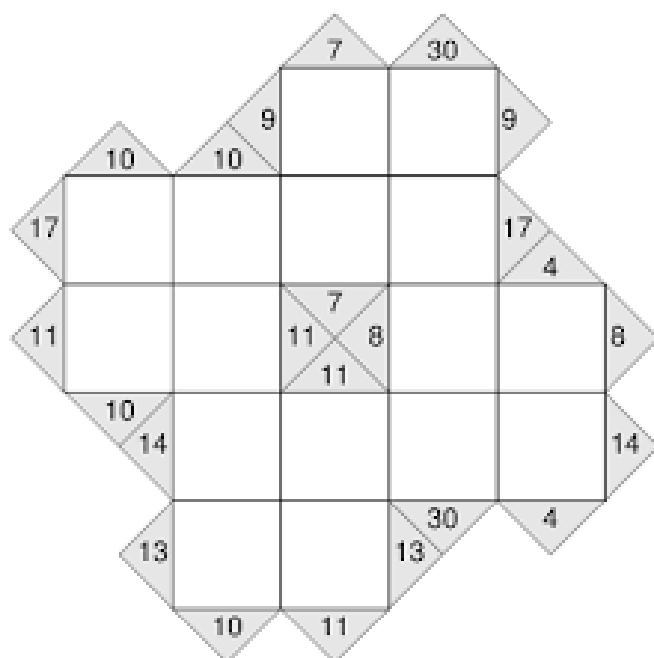
